

## Age Divisions and Qualifications

- Recreational teams only
- Boys or Coed U10-16
- Girls Only U10-16
- Teams are limited to a maximum roster of 12 players for U10, and 18 players for U12 and up.
- U10 teams play 6 per side and will use GYSA modified rules (to be included in Acceptance Package)
- U11 and up teams will play 11 per side and use GYSA rules.
- Teams are allowed up to 3 guest players not to exceed roster limit
- Athena, Premier, Classic and Challenge guest players are prohibited.
- No player may be registered on more than one team
- No in-house all-star teams are allowed.



## Documentation

Each team must provide at or before registration, the following:

- Current USYSA Player Passes laminated with player's picture and signature.
- Medical and Liability Release available on website.
- Two copies of their certified state issued USYSA Team Roster
- Permission to travel (out of state teams only) including guest players
- 4 completed team game cards to be mailed in acceptance package
